### **PAPD/CCSO Investigate Possibly Related Marijuana Dispensary Burglaries:**

The Port Angeles Police Department and Clallam County Sheriff's Office are asking for the public's help to assist in the investigation of burglaries to local marijuana dispensaries.

In the early morning hours of July 25<sup>th</sup>, 2018, Clallam County Deputy responded to a burglary in the 3200 block of E Highway 101. The responding deputy found that the business had been entered by force. (CCSO 2018-16308.)

In the early morning hours of August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2018, Port Angeles Officers responded to an alarm in the 1200 block of E Front Street. Responding officers found that entry had been forced into the business and multiple items had been stolen. (PAPD 2018-15121.)

Video surveillance was recovered in both incidents and are being analyzed by law enforcement. Both burglaries were committed by a group of four subjects wearing black, face masks, and gloves.

Anyone with information on these crimes is urged to contact local law enforcement.
