Chair Margolis commented that the board would skip this section as this time since a quorum was not present to approve the minutes.

**INFORMATION:**

Fire Department Report: Chief Gage noted that Chief Sharp was in South Dakota inspecting the new fire engine. In December, the department received a new electric stair chair with grant funding from L&I FIIRE. The CPM office has been sustained for an additional 2 years through 2027 with various grants. PAFD has been training hard, they have done TECC, ALS child delivery training this year. City Council accepted the AFG grant for new portable radios. Chief Gage shared call statistics year to date.

Police Department Report: Chief Smith began by discussing a couple of high-profile cases that have recently been in the news. Chief Smith spoke briefly about the Stone Garden Patrols, which are FEMA grant-funded shifts that allow for extra coverage. PenCom is fully staffed.

The Clerk confirmed with Chair Margolis that there was now a quorum for the meeting.
