Which WA State accredited wastewater laboratory will you be using to analyze your wastewater samples?

- Final approval of trucked discharge and determination of the hauler's per gallon charge will depend on lab analysis of a representative sample of the occasional/other wastewater in question.
- The hauler must submit annual (January through December) representative samples of the hauled wastewater to a WA state accredited laboratory for analysis at the hauler's expense, and report those results to the City of Port Angeles wastewater pretreatment specialist on the City's provided template, with the application for following year's occasional/other waste hauler permit.
- Monitoring frequency and parameters monitored will depend on the initial sampling results referred to in the first bullet, and will be specified on the City-provided reporting template.
- Occasional/Other wastewater must be sampled for monitoring prior to being loaded into the tanker truck to prevent contamination of the samples with previously hauled materials.
- The hauler must submit a City-supplied manifest to the wastewater treatment plant for every load of occasional/other wastewater discharged, and will be billed for a full load according to the tanker's rated capacity. Manifest must be clearly marked "Occasional/Other Waste" to avoid being billed as septic waste.
- The hauler must not mix occasional/other wastewater load with any other wastewater (not requiring tank washing between loads, just forbidding mixed or mingled loads).

- The charge for discharge of occasional/other waste shall be as prescribed in P.A.M.C. 3.70.110.F.7. The current charge for “other waste” is \$0.05 per gallon, but this rate can be changed if the City revises P.A.M.C. 3.70.110.F.7.
- Wastewater must be delivered to the wastewater treatment plant between 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except City holidays.
- The City reserves the right to suspend septage deliveries due to high flows and as needed for maintenance of the headworks area or other parts of the plant.
- The City reserves the right to refuse non-domestic wastes.
- “Occasional/Other” waste haulers must ensure their loads do not violate any of the sewer use ordinance prohibitions found in P.A.M.C. 13.06.030. Specifically, the pH of all loads must not be lower than 5.0 or higher than 11.0.
- Failure to comply with these conditions may result in immediate suspension of the permit and/or penalties as allowed by law.

I/we have personally examined and are familiar with the information contained in this application and believe that the submitted information is true, accurate, and complete. In addition, I/we are aware of the following conditions and requirements of the Occasional/Other Waste Hauler Permit for the City of Port Angeles and agree to meet them at all times. Failure to comply with permit conditions may result in the immediate suspension of the permit and/or possible penalties as outlined in the Port Angeles Municipal Code.

In addition, in compliance with the Port Angeles Municipal Code, and in consideration of the issuance of this Occasional/Other Waste Hauler Permit to the undersigned providing for the discharge of waste into the City of Port Angeles Wastewater Treatment Plant, the undersigned for himself/herself and for their successors and interest, hereby agrees to save and to defend the City from, and hold the City harmless against any claims or lawsuits for personal injury or property damage arising out of, or in any way connected with the Occasional/Other Waste Hauler Permit, except for injuries or damage caused by the sole negligence of the City of Port Angeles or its agents.
